MG Brian Mennes was commissioned a second lieutenant of Infantry in May 1988 from the United States Military Academy at West Point with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering.

MG Mennes first duty assignment was as a Platoon Leader and Battalion Logistics Officer in the 7th Infantry Division, Fort Ord, California with service in Panama for Operation Just Cause.

MG Mennes served in numerous command and staff positions in the 75th Ranger Regiment, the Joint Special Operations Command, 2nd and 7th Infantry Divisions, the 82nd Airborne Division, US Army Cadet Command, and the Department of the Army Staff as Director of Force Management for the Headquarters Department of the Army G-3/5/7. His overseas tours include the Sinai Desert and Korea, as well as ten deployments in support of operations in Panama, Afghanistan, and Iraq.

He most recently served as the Deputy Chief of Staff, Operations, Resolute Support Mission, North Atlantic Treaty Organization/Deputy Commanding General (Operations), U.S. Forces Afghanistan/Commander, U.S. National Support Element Command – Afghanistan, Operation Freedom's Sentinel, Afghanistan. Prior to his current assignment, MG Mennes was Commanding General of the 10th Mountain Division.

His professional military education includes the Infantry Basic and Advanced Courses, US Army Command and General Staff College (Master of Military Arts and Science Degree), Senior Service College Fellowship - Institute of World Politics, and the Joint and Combined Warfighting School.

MG Mennes' awards and decorations include the Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit (w/4 bronze oak leaf clusters), Bronze Medal (w/4 bronze oak leaf clusters), Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (w/1 silver and 1 bronze oak leaf clusters), Combat Infantryman Badge, Expert Infantryman Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, Air Assault Badge, Pathfinder Badge, and Ranger Tab.
